

Broad Oak Remote Learning Policy Statement

September 2020

The United Kingdom Government guidance on Education and Childcare during Coronavirus informs the requirements for remote learning during the contexts of individual (family) self-isolation and for a year group bubble self-isolating.

Intent:

In the event of pupil self-isolation (whatever the context) we will:

- Provide meaningful lessons based where possible on on-going class based education
- Ensure there is consistency in the approach to remote learning for pupils not in school
- Minimise disruption in a manner to support pupil and family well-being
- Use basic technology to support learning across the curriculum and ensure that it is accessible to all pupils (or provide paper copies where needed)
- Tailor the learning offer to specific individual needs eg additional maths lessons or 1-1 sessions (Reading and Saplings/Acorns)

Implementation:

All work for remote learning can be accessed via Seesaw. Teachers will save their lessons on the library on Seesaw

Year Group Bubble Isolation:

Expectations of Teachers, Teaching Assistants (TAs) and SLT

In advance of a bubble closure:

- Teachers to produce one day's 'general' Maths, English and Topic based video lessons ready to post on Seesaw on the first day of a bubble self-isolation.
- Teachers adopt the model daily timetable (see appendix 1). It should contain an introductory message.
- Teachers explain during autumn 1, the remote learning expectations to their pupils and how to access content. This must be revisited each half term.
- Teachers ensure pupils know their usernames/passwords and can use them to access Reading Plus, TT Rock stars, Phonics Play, Spelling Shed and Seesaw.

When a bubble is closed:

- Day 1 Teachers post the 'general' pre-prepared work onto Seesaw
- Day 2 onwards Please pre-record a message to your class each day and post it on Seesaw, outlining expectations for that day. This must be posted by 9:00 a.m. on each school day.
- Teachers produce daily video lessons either pre-recorded or live via Zoom complementing the content of current class teaching for the subsequent days of self-isolation.
- For the Early Years remote learning offer (see appendix 2)

- For Years 1-6, there will be a daily lesson for English and Maths (based on White Rose Maths).
- Other daily tasks such as Reading (Oxford Owl or Reading Plus), Spelling (Spelling Shed) and Times tables (TT Rock stars)
- Lessons in other subjects will be posted in accordance with the weekly timetable. Teachers can create their own video resources or use pre-prepared resources e.g. Oak Academy, BBC Bitesize etc.
- Lessons need to include information on how pupils' work will be responded to and/or marked.
- Teachers must be available from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. to respond daily to any work or queries that are shared by pupils or parents via Seesaw. Colleagues will determine when they will take breaks within these times.
- Teachers will reflect on parental responses. They will use this information to hone their provision and contact families if necessary
- If they're unable to work for any reason during this time, for example due to sickness or caring for a dependent, they should report this using the normal absence procedure.
- Teaching assistants will reinstate their 1-1 sessions via zoom where possible.
- Teaching assistants must be available from 9.00am until 3.00pm. They will determine when they take breaks within these times.
- If they're unable to work for any reason during this time, for example due to sickness or caring for a dependent, they should report this using the normal absence procedure.
- Subject co-ordinators will support class teachers' to ensure a consistent approach to remote learning provision in their subject e.g. signpost resources to, record adaptations to the curriculum to facilitate remote learning. Monitoring curriculum coverage will inform the development of our Recovery Curriculum.
- SENCO will reinstate the family welfare calls for those identified as vulnerable and record outcomes. This will be shared with SLT and admin as necessary. Urdu, Bengali and some European language speaking families will be contacted by specific members of our staff.
- SLT will monitor remote learning provision and impact (see below).
- Safeguarding children and families– All staff have read and understood safeguarding requirements (Staff Handbook, September 2020). They know our reporting procedures and DSLs.
- Safeguarding colleagues do not share personal email addresses or telephone numbers with parents. If a colleague becomes uncomfortable with a parent's comments or tone during a welfare call or in response to an enquiry, they should politely tell the parent of their feelings then hang up and inform SLT.

Year Group Bubble Isolation – Expectations of Pupils

- Complete the daily lessons given.
- Ask for help if they are unsure of what to do via Seesaw.
- Send completed work to class teachers via Seesaw.

Individual Children Isolation – Expectations of Teachers, TAs and Pupils

- Remote learning provision will start on day 2 of school absence.
- English and Maths work should complement the content of current class teaching.
- Individual provision will be a factor for teachers to consider whenever they are planning and preparing their lessons.
- Dissemination of lessons can be delegated to class based Teaching Assistants.
- Teachers are not expected to prepare individual remote learning videos as they would for bubble closure.

- Pupils can make greater use of resources such as Oak Academy lessons. Links will be on the class Seesaw
- During welfare calls, families will be told they can also access any lessons posted by teachers for Year group bubbles they are in.

Impact

- Broad Oak accepts that remote learning uptake will be varied.
- The impact of remote learning will be determined using:
 - Pupils' responses on Seesaw and in the Zoom live lessons
 - Parental feedback via Seesaw and welfare calls
- Strategies to tackle low/no engagement include:
 - Day 1 if no activity on student Seesaw teacher to send message on the Family app to offer support or practical help
 - Day 2 if still no activity or response phone call to parents by class teacher to identify barrier to engagement/offer help
 - Day 3 if this continues teacher to report to phase leader/SLT
 - Day 4 SLT to ring and email parents
 - Day 5 if no contact has been made pass on to Safeguarding team who may consider doorstep home visit or onward referral
- Broad Oak will consider (on a case by case basis) the need to provide laptops or lpads that are required for remote learning.
- When additional IT resources become available, donated by MCC or central government, distribution will be in accordance with donor guidance and/or according to needs determined by Broad Oak Primary School.

Data Protection

Accessing and Processing Personal Data.

- Colleagues must only use school laptops and computers to access any pupil/staff data, interact with pupils/parents and for recording feedback.
- Colleagues can use school telephones to contact families e.g. responding to specific remote learning queries or for making family welfare calls. However, colleagues may prefer to use their personal mobile telephones but should only do so if they have blocked their number to prevent parents ringing back.
- Colleagues will need to collect and/or share our families personal data e.g. email addresses/telephone numbers, outcomes of wellbeing calls as part of our remote learning offer. As long as this processing is necessary for the school's official functions, individuals won't need to give permission for this to happen. Any data used for or generated in this way can only be stored on school equipment, server and licensed applications. Colleagues need to be mindful to collect and/or share as little personal data as possible online.

Monitoring and Review

- As remote learning provision is a recent adaptation to our practice, our offer will need to be reviewed in the light of feedback and experience at the end of each half term.
- Adaptations to the offer will be disseminated through staff meetings.
- Broad Oak's Headteacher will report on policy and practice at Governor meetings.
- This policy was presented to BO staff on 23/10/20 and to the Governors on 18/11/20 for approval.
