Dear Parents & Carers,

As you will be aware this week has been Children's Mental Health Week. This year's theme is 'Let's connect' and is about making meaningful connections. 










'In UKS2, we have been learning about how to protect our planet by being sustainable in Geography lessons. We have made posters to promote this'.









