A Norwegian island is campaigning to get rid of the concept of time, allowing the people who live there to do "what we want, when we want". Citizens of Sommaroy in West Tromso, north of the Arctic Circle, say that normal business hours should not apply to them because they do not experience time like the majority of the rest of the world. The sun doesn't rise in winter or set in summer on Sommaroy, leading most of the island's 300 residents to back a bid for it to become the world's first time-free zone.
