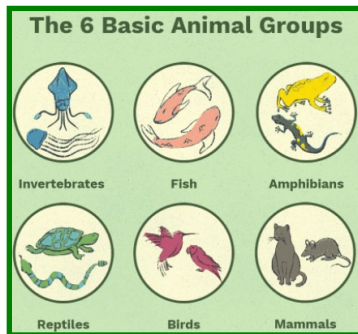
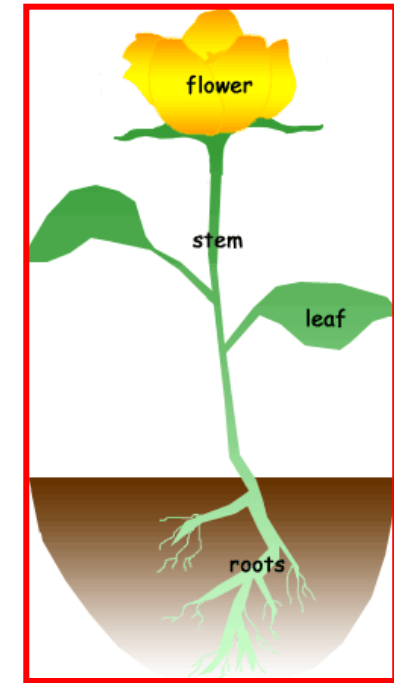


Knowledge Organiser: Enchanted Woodland!

woodland	A woodland is a large area of land covered in trees. There are many woodlands all over the UK.
mammals	Warm-blooded animals that feed milk to their young.
amphibian	Cold-blooded animals that live on land and in water but must lay their eggs in
reptile	Cold-blooded animals that usually have scales and lay eggs on land.
deciduous	Plants that lose their leaves in Autumn.
evergreen	Plants that keep their leaves all year round.
prey	Animals that are hunted, killed and eaten by other animals.
predator	Animals that hunt, kill and eat other animals.
herbivore	Animals that eat grass, roots, leaves and other non-meat foods.
carnivore	Predators that hunt, kill and eat other animals like worms, mice, birds and

Humans are animals.
The 5 main groups of animals are: birds, fish, mammals, amphibians and reptiles.
A plant is made up of different parts including: seed, stem, leaves, roots, flowers and petals.
To survive plants need: air, light, water, warmth.
To survive animals need: air, food, water, shelter.
Plants that drop their leaves in Autumn are called deciduous and a tree that keeps its leaves all year round is called evergreen.
